Only part of the wall would need to be rebuilt.

The bit by the playground could stay the same.

The bits above the benches would not need to be moved either.

This google image shows where the Folk Week marquee had been so makes it clear that my idea would not cause problems with the toilets.

The shadows show that the image was taken late morning which is the time the river walk gets most light. The time of year will be early to mid August.

At most times the height of the current flood defence wall and its proximity to the walk means that the walk is in shadow. Cranking the top half of the wall in the opposite direction will allow far more light and thus make it more welcoming.

Raising the walk itself will further reduce the shadowing effect.
