



SIDMOUTH CYCLING CAMPAIGN

RED ISSUES: Request for action

- **SeaFest.** We are planning a stall at SeaFest on 16th May to include a bicycle made of Willow and various activities. We have asked the Police if they could run a session to add security markings to bikes. We ask for a grant of £200 from the Town Council to purchase a Cycling Campaign flag, printing some flyers and other associated publicity costs.

AMBER ISSUES: Request for attention

- **Bottom of the Byes.** We have suggestions for a safer road crossing at the bottom of the Byes that we intend to submit to Devon County Council and seek support from the Town Council later this year.

GREEN: Points of interest

- **Cycling to School.** We helped organise a cycle ride to school from Sidbury in the autumn that made the front page of the Sidmouth Herald. We have discussed, with Bikeability Instructors, opportunities for further promotion this year.
- **Road Closure to Tipton.** We are pressing Devon County Council to allow cyclists to use the length of road from the Bowd to Tipton that has been closed due to subsidence.
- **Heaths to Sea Project.** Clinton Devon is due to submit a funding bid to Defra, this month, for this Project (heathstosea.com) From our discussions with them we are hopeful this will include proposals for off road cycle routes.
- **Sidford to Sidbury Path.** The Devon County Council proposal for this path appears to be dependent on a planning application for housing in Sidbury. We're monitoring this application.
- **SVA Children's Activity Day.** We are planning an activity for this event on 16th April.
- **Drop kerbs.** We have asked Devon County Council to consider installing dropped kerbs at 2 locations to assist cyclists and mobility scooters.
